Bishop Hee-Soo Jung Assigned to the Ohio Episcopal Area

Bishop Hee-Soo Jung has been assigned to The Ohio Episcopal Area which includes the East and West Ohio Conferences. His assignment will begin September 1, 2024.

Bishop Jung is the resident bishop in the Wisconsin Annual Conference and has served in this role since September of 2012. He played a key role in Wisconsin's Imagine No Malaria Campaign, which raised more than \$1 million.

Prior to leading the Wisconsin Conference UMC, Bishop Jung served eight years as bishop of the Northern Illinois Conference (Chicago area). He was instrumental in inspiring the Harvest 2020 movement in Northern Illinois, which resulted in many new faith communities. *Read more...*

Mustard Seed Migration Grants

Every day, thousands of people flee their homes in search of a better life for their families. Global Ministries and the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) provide support for refugees and migrants around the world, seeking to fulfill the biblical mandate to "love thy neighbor" and "welcome the stranger."



The Mustard Seed Migration Grant program is designed to encourage local United Methodist churches to engage in ministry to migrants in their midst. UMCOR will award grants of \$2,000 to up to 100 United Methodist local churches in the U.S. to engage in new, one-time community-based service projects and ministries focused on migrants and refugees. The goal of this program is to nurture a deeper understanding and care for the most vulnerable in our communities.

Local Church Grants fund ministries and projects that help local churches reach people more effectively with the healing love and grace of Jesus Christ. Grant funding is available for



New and Emerging Ministries, Adaptive Ministry, Social Justice Ministry, Ministry with Young People, and Outreach Ministry. These annual grants are distributed quarterly.

Non-Profit Agency Mission Partner Grants are available to agencies whose mission is in alignment with the mission of the District and Conference and have relationships with local United Methodist churches and/or the Great Miami River District. These annual grants are distributed monthly.

Healthy Boundaries/Clergy Sexual Ethics/Safer Sanctuaries Essential Trainings

On behalf of the Episcopal Office and the Board of Ordained Ministry, we are pleased to invite you to an essential training event designed for both lay staff and clergy. This event aims to reinforce our commitment to maintaining safe and respectful environments within our communities. We encourage clergy to invite one key lay staff person to attend the Safer Sanctuaries Training with you for the afternoon session.



All Clergy under appointment, including those in Extension Ministries, Lay Pulpit Supply, and all Certified Lay Ministers within the West Ohio Conference, are now required to undergo a comprehensive background check every four years. Clergy on Leave of Absence are also encouraged to participate in the training and background check updates as they are able.

To facilitate this, please register for your preferred training event and complete the "Permission to Release Information" form by August 15, 2024, which can be found here: **Background Check Form.** The required training is to be fully completed by November 21, 2024.



Discover FX is coming to the Great Miami River District! You've heard about Fresh Expressions popping up all across West Ohio. Here is your chance to explore how fresh expressions could revitalize your church and reach people in your community. They are an
